

Music Monday

On Monday May 1, we will showcase learning and making music in our schools, communities and across Canada during a normal school day. Launched in 2005 by The Coalition for Music Education, **Music Monday** is the world's largest single event dedicated to raising awareness for music education. The idea is that if one were to open the front door of his or her home and stand on the street on the first Monday in May, one would hear music and the skies would be filled with melody.
